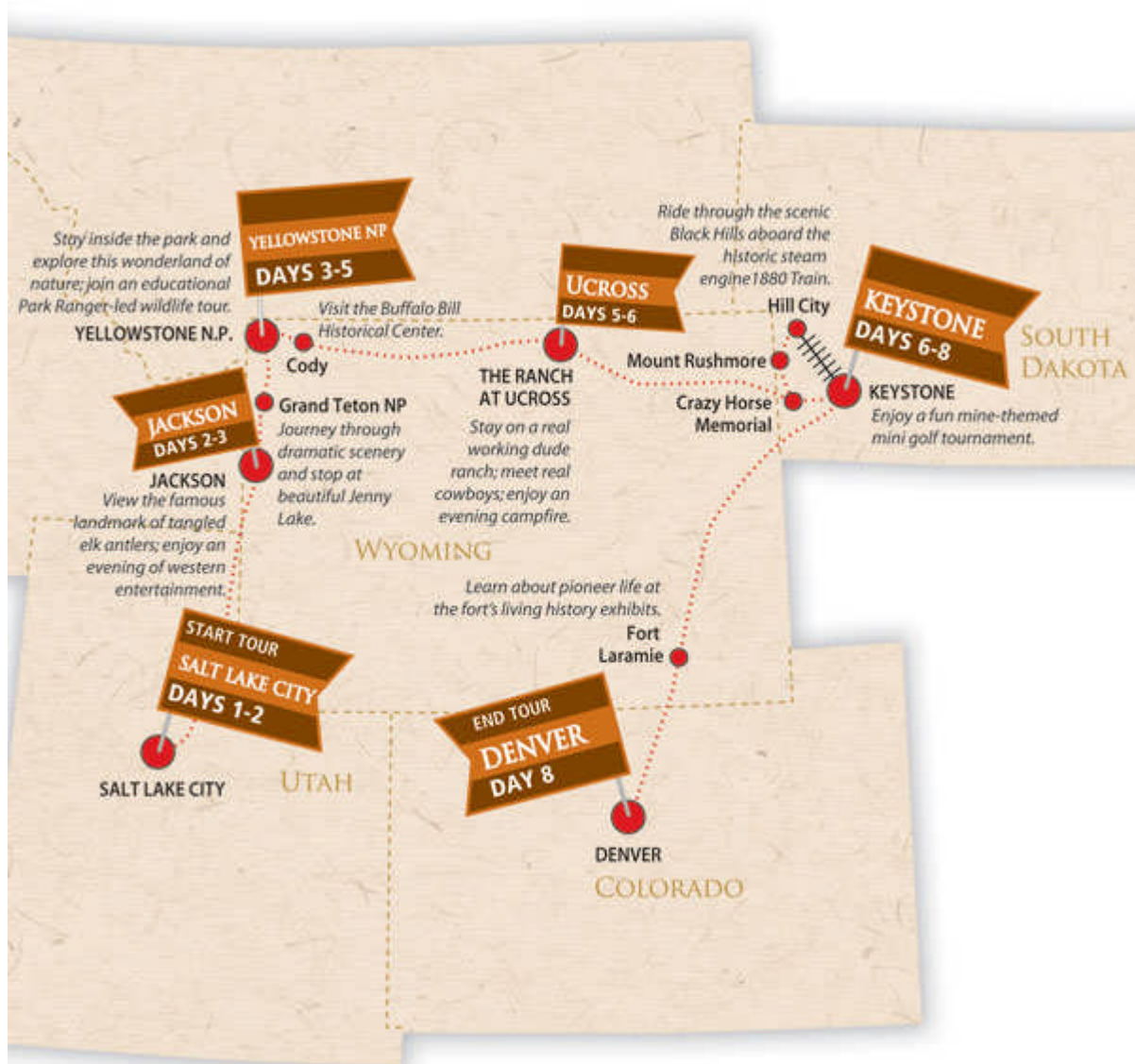

## **Wild West Cowboys & Buffalos 2010**

### **Day 1 - Arrive Salt Lake City**

Welcome to Salt Lake City! After landing at the airport, you'll be whisked away to your hotel. Meet your Tour Director this afternoon. This evening join us at 6:00pm for a Kick-off Party at the hotel.

### **Day 2 - Salt Lake City – Jackson**

Put on your cowboy hats and get ready for the journey of a lifetime. Today your Tour Director will reveal a Hidden Treasure! Heading north, skirt the Great Salt Lake as you enter Wyoming. Follow trails blazed by rugged pioneers, across the Oregon Trail and Snake River to the Old West town of Jackson. Surrounded by the majestic Rockies, you'll enjoy western boardwalks with various shops and boutiques. Come nightfall savor a western-style Chuckwagon Dinner and Show. (Full breakfast / Highlight dinner)

### **Day 3 - Jackson – Grand Teton – Yellowstone National Park (2 nights)**

This morning you can opt to take a fun and educational float trip down the Snake River. Later, discover the grandeur of Grand Teton National Park, Jenny Lake, and the world's first national park, Yellowstone. This natural haven is highlighted by a visit to Old Faithful, a geyser which has been continuously spouting water every hour for thousands of years. Next, kids have a chance to earn their Junior Ranger Badge at the Visitor Center. (Full breakfast / Dinner)

### **Day 4 - Yellowstone National Park sightseeing**

The early morning is the best time to spot native wildlife. Join a Park Ranger-led wildlife walk to search for bison, beaver, birds, elk and bears. Later on, discover Yellowstone's most amazing natural wonders, including the thundering Yellowstone Falls, a multitude of hot gushing geysers, as well as an otherworldly collection of brilliantly colored thermal springs, bubbling mud pools, and hissing steam vents. (Full breakfast)

### Day 5 - Yellowstone – Cody – The Ranch At Ucross

You'll travel through rugged country on your way to the town of Cody, named for Buffalo Bill Cody. Explore the Buffalo Bill Historical Center and the world's largest collection of western artifacts. Then get ready for a taste of true cowboy lifestyle at the Ranch at Ucross, a working dude ranch located in the foothills of the Bighorn Mountains. This evening, you'll indulge in a typical Ranch-style Highlight Dinner and an evening filled with stories and s'mores around the campfire. (Full breakfast / Highlight dinner)

### Day 6 - The Ranch At Ucross – Crazy Horse – Keystone (2 nights)

After a hearty breakfast, enjoy activities galore on the ranch – all included! Learn the workings of the ranch, ride horses through the hills, fish for trout in Piney Creek, play tennis and horseshoes, or simply relax poolside. Early afternoon, head to Thunderhead Mountain and gaze in awe at Crazy Horse Memorial, the world's largest sculpture. Later you'll reach Keystone, once a gold mining boomtown. This evening view the moving ceremonial lighting at Mount Rushmore. (Full breakfast)

### Day 7 - Keystone & Black Hills excursion

The first stop this morning is Bear Country USA, the largest private collection of American Black Bear. Next, re-visit Mount Rushmore National Park during the day. Then it's... All Aboard! Ride the 1880 Train, an authentic steam engine, from Hill City back to Keystone, winding through the beautiful Black Hills. At the Holy Terror Mini Golf, sign up for a miniature golf tournament! This evening, join your fellow adventurers at a Farewell Dinner and toast to your Wild West adventures. (Full breakfast / Farewell dinner)

### Day 8 - Keystone – Depart Denver

Follow the trail to old Fort Laramie, the best-known milepost on the Oregon Trail. At the fort's living history exhibits, gain a deeper understanding of the harsh environment pioneers faced and the resistance of Native Americans. Your Wild West adventure comes to an end at the Mile High city of Denver where stops are made at Denver International Airport or, if you're extending your stay, at the tour hotel in the heart of Downtown Denver. (Full breakfast)
